The 2 cleans on the A route went to John Roberts and Tim Wheeler with a lot of low scores from occasional dabs. 50/50 honours went to Merv Walker on his Fantic. The B route again had 2 cleans, Kevin Westlake taking one and Jon Cull on his rigid the other showing that you don't need all the fancy suspension to put in a good result. The C route attracted 4 cleans from Brian Ayres, Richard Clarke, Tom Berryman and Nick Rundle. It was entertaining to watch Tom go through section 1 as though he was at a motorcross event.

The 50/50 route attracted 12 riders with the C route having 10 which shows they are a useful addition to the Bath Classic trials.

As always we are extremely grateful for the observers who had to contend with the wind and rain although it did give us a chance to test the new waterproof score cards which worked extremely well.
